## BLS Provider CPR/AED Course:

### **Minimum number of students required: 6**

This course is designed to teach skills and knowledge of adult one- and two-man CPR, pediatric CPR, AED and the management of the choking patient. This course requires the successful completion of a written and skills evaluation. This course is intended for those individuals who respond to pre-hospital situations, or any Healthcare Provider. A course completion card is issued for this course with re-certification every two years. This course is the mandatory certification for all medically licensed providers such as RN, EMT, First Responder, and etcetera.

**Note:** In order for any In-State Volunteer Fire/Ambulance Companies/Police Agencies to qualify for the listed price, they must have prepurchased the required materials for this course. Contact the Fire School to order these materials.

This course is designed to verify the skills portion for the **BLS for Healthcare Provider or HeartCode for BLS CPR/AED Online Course**. Participants must complete the online content and present an official AHA certificate to be eligible to participate in the skills portion **within 60 days of completion of the online content**. A course completion card is issued for this course with re-certification every two years. A course completion card is issued for this course with re-certification every two years. This course is the mandatory certification for all medically licensed providers such as RN, EMT, First Responder, and etcetera.

The difference between the two online courses is the method in which the content is delivered. HeartCode BLS Part 1 delivers the content through eSimulation, where students interact in real-time with the patient scenarios, while content in BLS for Healthcare Providers Online Part 1 is delivered through interactive question and answer lessons, mini-games and video segments.
