

FEMA Student Identification Numbers

Students attending National Fire Academy Programs through the Delaware State Fire School are required to have their Student Identification Number (SID) for registration.

A FEMA SID is required to register for and participate in any training provided by FEMA. All FEMA training providers' registration systems and enrollment procedures require a valid FEMA SID. The FEMA SID will serve as your unique identifier and be used to maintain the record of FEMA training you attended. *No course registration forms will be processed through FEMA without this number.*

How to Register for a SID

Go to <https://cdp.dhs.gov/FEMASID/>

Click on the "Register for a FEMA SID" button near the top of the page.

Complete the required fields in the application and click "Register".

You should receive an email confirmation with your SID when the process is complete.

To Find Your SID

(For those who have registered but do not remember it)

GO to the same page (<https://cdp.dhs.gov/FEMASID/>) and Click the "Forgot your FEMA SID?" button.

Use the email you used to register for your SID. (Be sure to update your email to receive notifications.)

Tips on Creating and Using Your SID

Use an email that you will continue to have access to in case you need to reset your password for logging in for online training or registering for any FEMA courses. You can also have an alternate email to help with this process.

Keep your SID saved or written down to refer to for any FEMA course.
