

NFPA 1021 Challenge



EXCELLENCE THROUGH TRAINING

This challenge is designed to allow the Firefighter looking to to challenge the Proboard NFPA 1021-2018, Fire Officer 1, 2, 3, or 4 Certification. Candidates will be required to successfully pass a written examination of each standard they challenge.

The Candidate will be required to complete a set of written skills or have attended and passed a Delaware State Fire School Officer Course

within the past 2 Years



before the scheduled testing date.

Dates and Times

Written Testing shall be conducted at: Kent Division, 1461 Chestnut Grove Road, Dover, DE

Fire Officer Candidates MUST assure that all Skills have been successfully submitted before applying for written testing.

All retests may be scheduled, but MUST be more than 15 days after the failure, and no more than 1 year since the failure.

Any failed skills MUST be revised and resubmitted within 1 year of successful passing of the written test.

Skills will be evaluated when submitted, but may take up to 2 months depending on evaluator availablity.

Fire Officer I, II, III, or IV Certification Examinations

{Written Test and Skills Only}

These examinations allow Candidates who meet the necessary prerequisites to challenge a nationally recognized examination for the purpose of being certified under the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications. The written examination for Fire Officer I, II, III, & IV certification consists of multiple-choice questions. Fire Officer I, II, & III tests are 100 multiple-choice questions. Test questions are based on NFPA 1021-2020 Standard for Fire Officer I, II, III, & IV, also IFSTA "Fire and Emergency Services Company Officer", 6th Edition for Fire Officer I & II, or IFSTA "Fire and Emergency Services Chief Officer", 4th Edition for Fire Officer III & IV.

Skills Assignments

Unless Candidates have taken and passed, DSFS Fire Officer I, II, III, or IV course (respectively) within the last 24 months, each Candidate testing for Fire Officer I & II will be given an assignment package before arriving at the written exam. The package includes all skills that are required to be completed within 1 year of the successful passing and may be turned in before the test day.

> NOTE: Applicants will receive a confirmation by mail or email upon acceptance. Applicant must bring a copy of a photo ID on test day to be admitted.
