Delaware State Fire School Firefighter 1 & 2 Certification - Skills Challenge Guide

The Delaware State Fire School continues to offer certification challenges to those candidates who have successfully met any training and/or certification prerequisites to qualify for testing.

In addition to written testing, candidates shall be required to perform all skills stations successfully in order to complete the process and receive certification.

Skills may be tested individually, in sets of skills at a station, or multiple, similar skills may be combined into a single of evolution in a station.

Skills that may be evaluated:

Firefighter 1

Mandatory Optional (may also be used) -Donning PPE & SCBA -Doffing SCBA & PPE -PPE & SCBA inspection/maintenance -Use of a hose line & nozzle -PPE field decontamination -Hoist a tool using a clove hitch or bowline -Forcing an inward and/or outward door -Traffic control area setup -Ladder carries and raises -Procedure for a primary/secondary search -Operate a hydrant -Assist a conscious or unconscious victim down a -Make a straight or donut hose roll ladder -Securing building utilities -Ventilate a flat and/or pitched roof -Passenger vehicle fire attack -Direct and/or indirect attack -Construct a water chute/catchall -Setup a generator and lights -Pull a ceiling/Open an interior wall -Wildland/Ground cover fire -Fold a salvage cover

Firefighter 2

Optional (may also be used) Mandatory -Service and test fire hose -Inspecting, servicing & maintenance of a -Use an in-line foam inductor generator -Extinguish a flammable liquid fire -Stabilize a vehicle using cribbing & wheel chock -Stabilize a vehicle using a buttress system -Control/Extinguish a flammable gas fire -Remove a windshield from a vehicle -Establish incident command -Remove tempered glass from a vehicle -Protect evidence of fire cause and origin -Remove a door from a vehicle -Conduct a fire safety survey -Remove a roof from a vehicle -Create a fire and life safety presentation -Displace a dashboard on a vehicle -Prepare a preincident planning survey
