NFPA 1072 Challenge

EXCELLENCE THROUGH TRAINING

This challenge is designed to allow the Candidate to challenge the Proboard NFPA 1072-2018, Hazardous Materials Awareness and/or Operations Level Certification.

Candidates will be required to successfully pass a written examination of each standard they challenge. Skills will have been completed in the DSFS Hazardous Materials Operations Course (Awareness and Operations (PPE & Product Control) DSFS Basic Fire Firefighting

Skills or EMT class (Awareness), and/or Hazardous Materials Response Skills (Operations), or equivalent.

Dates and Times

Written Testing shall be conducted at:
Kent Division, 1461 Chestnut Grove Road, Dover, DE on scheduled testing center dates.

Candidates MAY test for both Awareness and operations level Certifications Simultaneously, so long as they meet the DSFS Prerequisites of Basic Firefighting Skills and Hazardous Materials Response Skills. They should use this application to register for these tests.

Candidates seeking NFPA 1001/1010 requiring 1072 prerequisite need to only use that application to test for those levels needed on that testing date.

There is NO skills challenge available with the written testing at this time.

You **must** have a Delaware Learning Center Account and password available on the test date in order to test.

Hazardous Materials Awareness and/or Operations Certification Examinations **(Written Examination Only)**

The written examination for Hazardous Materials and Operations certification is to allow firefighters who meet the necessary prerequisites to challenge a nationally recognized examination for the purpose of being certified under the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications. The examination consists of multiple-choice questions. Test questions and required skill evolutions, are based on the NFPA 1072. It is suggested that the applicants use the NFPA 1072-2019 Standard for Hazardous Materials and the **IFSTA Essentials of Fire Fighting and Fire Department Operations, 6th Edition** or the IFSTA **Hazardous Materials for First Responder, 5th Edition** as a study guide for the written tests and practical evaluations.

Practical Evaluation

Candidates **MUST** have completed **DSFS Basic Firefighting Skills, DSFS Hazardous Materials Awareness class** or a **pre-approved** Hazardous Materials Awareness Course for **Hazardous Materials Awareness** testing. Candidates shall have completed **DSFS Hazardous Materials Response Skills** or an equivalent, **pre-approved** Out-of-State Hazardous Materials Operations Level Course for **Hazardous Materials Operations** testing. Applicants will need to make special arrangements confirm the Out-of-State Hazardous Materials course and associated skills are approved **before** the written examination. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance and which day they need to attend to complete the testing.

NOTICE

If meeting **all** pre-requisites for both Awareness and Operations testing, a combined certification test for both levels is available. Please note the pre-requisites in order to be eligible upon applying. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance and which day they need to attend to complete the testing.

Hazardous Materials Awareness Certification Prerequisite requirements and training

- At least 14 years of age
- Completion of DSFS Basic Firefighting Skills, DSFS EMT course Completion, **OR** Hazardous Materials Awareness Course

Hazardous Materials Operations Certification Prerequisite requirements and training

- At least 16 years of age
- Completion of DSFS Hazardous Materials Response Skills Course
- Hazardous Materials Awareness Pro Board or IFSAC Certificate

Hazardous Materials Awareness & operations COMBINED Certification **Prerequisite requirements and training**

- At least 16 years of age
- Completion of DSFS Basic Firefighting Skills, DSFS EMT course Completion, **OR** Hazardous Materials Awareness Course
- Completion of DSFS Hazardous Materials Response Skills Course or DSFS Hazardous Materials Operations Course
